Chapel Hill State School is again gearing up for next year's Prep intake for students born between the 1st of July 2019 and the 30th of June 2020.

At our school, we have a strong and purposeful Prep transition program that focuses on welcoming new families and transitioning our new students into our school. We will be hosting a suite of events that will help provide a positive mindset to the new and exciting start of their learning journey.

Some of the upcoming transition events include the following:

Festival on the Hill – Saturday, 8th June, from 1pm to dark.

This is a great time for new families to drop into our school and gain a real 'feel' for our school community. We will also be opening some of our Prep rooms from 1:30 – 2:30pm and this will provide new parents the chance to meet some of our staff and gain an initial sense of the Walker Learning Approach.

Prep 2025 Parent Information Session and Guided Tours –Thursday, 13th June 9:15am to 10:30am in the Hall

This session provides information about our approach to teaching and learning in the early years and insights into a typical day in Prep as well as specific information regarding the 2025 Prep intake (including information about our <u>Enrolment Management Plan</u>). The program will include small guided tours to give parents a chance to take a 'sneak peek' into some of our early years' classrooms.

Please note that this event is intended for an adult audience only.

We respectfully ask that you make alternative arrangements for your children. Prep 2025 students will have multiple opportunities to meet teachers and visit classrooms as part of our comprehensive Transition Program in Term 3 and 4.

Some Other Prep Transition Events

<u>Storytime and Play Sessions</u>: The school will run a number of fun Storytime and Play sessions in Term 3 and Term 4. These will be optional sessions for our soon-to-be students and provide another positive experience to help in the transitioning to school.

<u>Smart Start Orientation Sessions:</u> In Term 4, we will be running a number of orientation sessions, four in total, starting Wednesday 30th October, and concluding on Wednesday 20th November. During these sessions, 2025 Prep students will have a chance to experience Prep activities let by our teaching staff, while parents will participate in presentations providing key messages.

<u>Parent / Prep Teacher Interviews</u> (just prior to first day at school): We offer an optional drop-in session for parents and students to briefly meet the Teacher and Teacher Aide and some of the friends joining the class. This is particularly useful should your child be feeling anxious about starting school or if you'd like to discuss specific matters such as learning/health needs of your child.
