This funding will be used to:

- Meet all of CHSS set targeted reading levels across the school
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students receiving an A or B in English/Mathematics/Science to 80%
- Increase the percentage of Year 4 students receiving an A or B in English/Mathematics/Science to 75%
- Increase the percentage of Year 6 students receiving an A or B in English/Mathematics/Science to 80%
- Prepare individualised student learning support initiatives to address learning goals.

Our initiatives include:

- Extending the release of the Walker Learning Approach as our signature Pedagogy (WLA: age appropriate pedagogy –Inquiry learning) into Year 4 and Year 6 while continuing to consolidate the practice in all other year levels
- Increasing the number of staff formally accredited in Walker Learning Approach
- Formal student goal setting (monitoring and tracking of student achievement) with programs that include the use of professional learning teams, teacher coaching and teacher feedback
- Delivery of a student learning enhancement model that is designed to tailor support for individual students in order to address individual needs.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- Delivering Walker Learning Approach across Prep to Year 6 via a detailed 2021 Support Program running Prep to Year 2 and Year 3 to Year 6 = \$45,000
- Provide teacher release time to develop tailored professional learning focussed on Big Five key areas = \$100,000
- Provide classroom resources that align with the delivery of our strategic plan's Big Five key areas= \$25,000
- Provide tailored learning support to enhance student learning via a formal teacher coaching/leadership model = \$89,251.
